

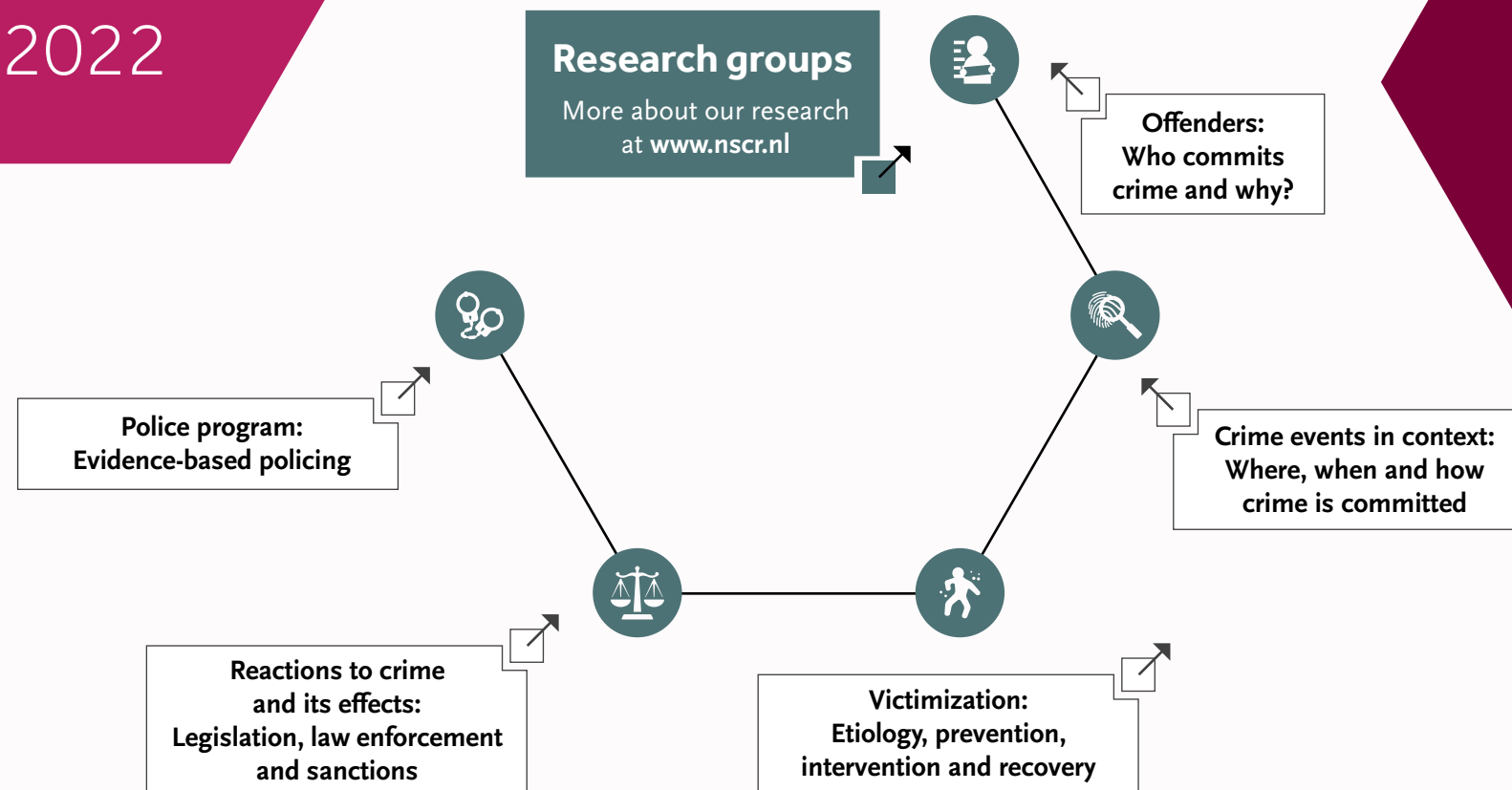

About NSCR

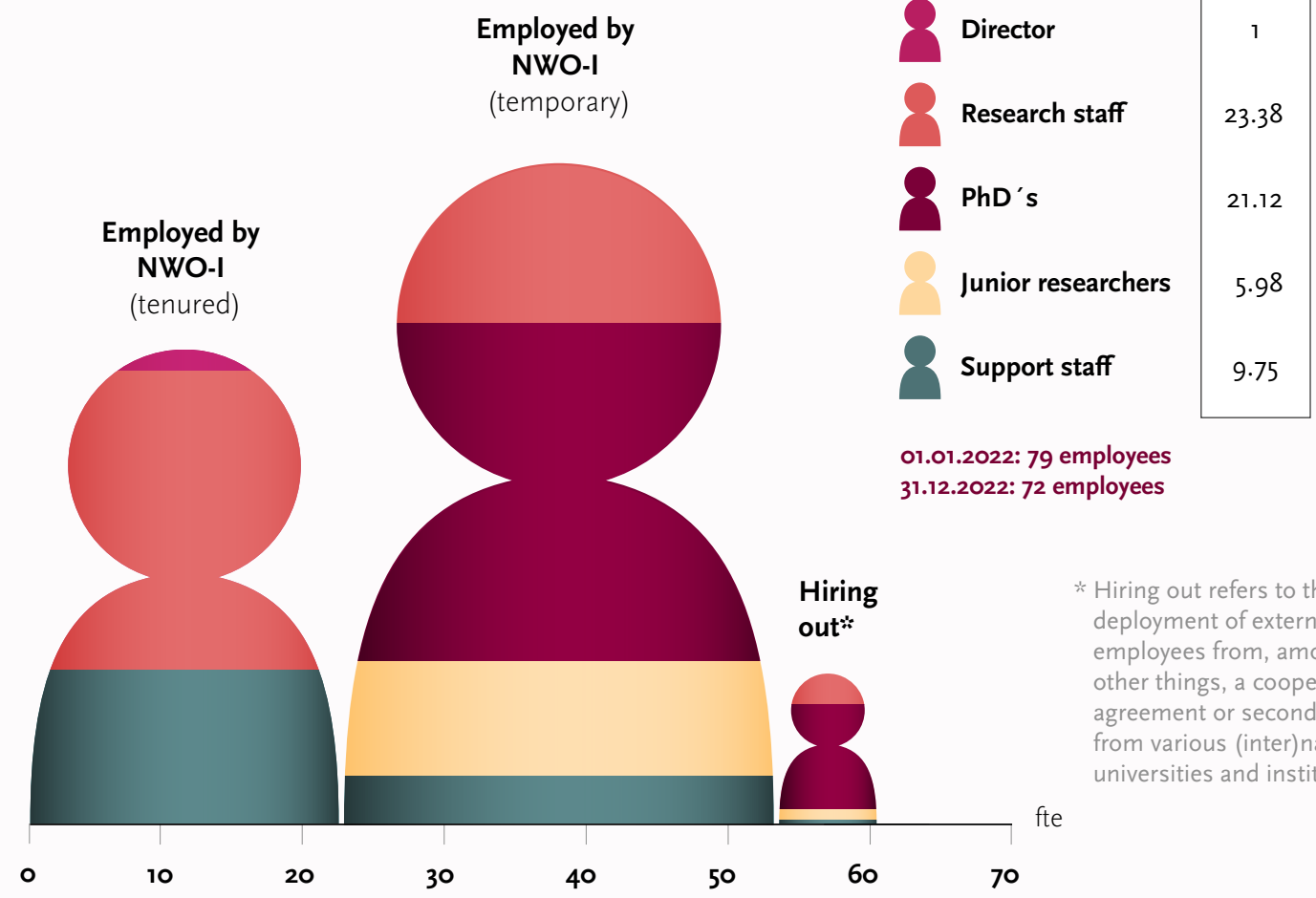
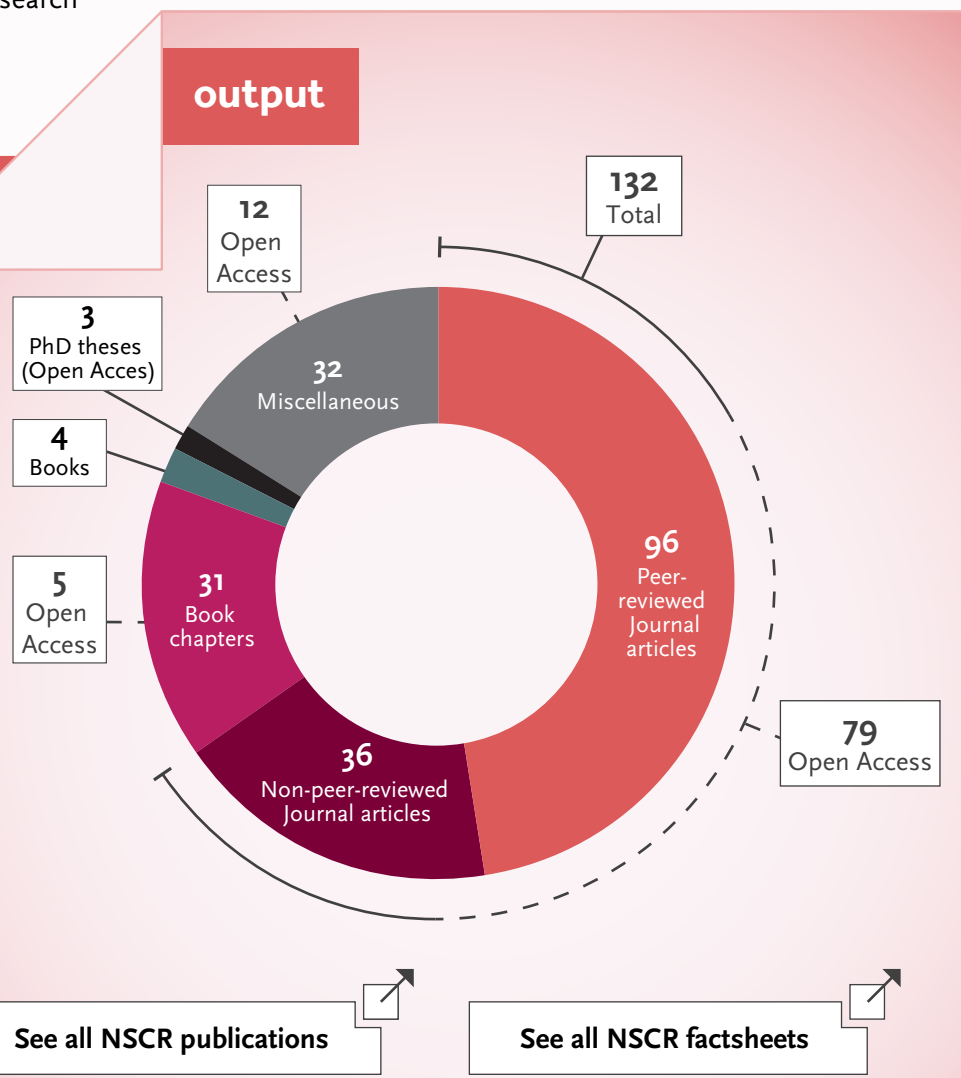

NSCR Research program

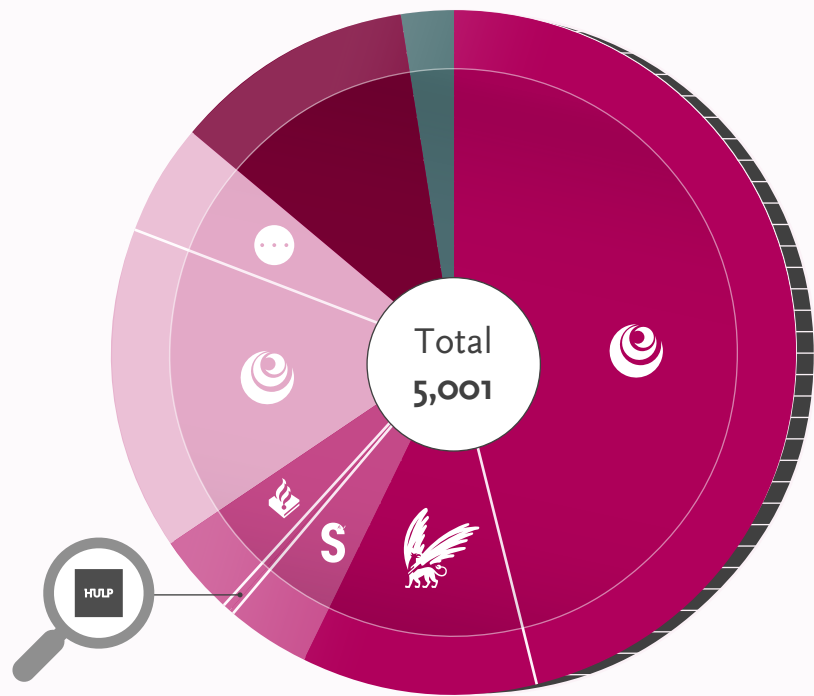

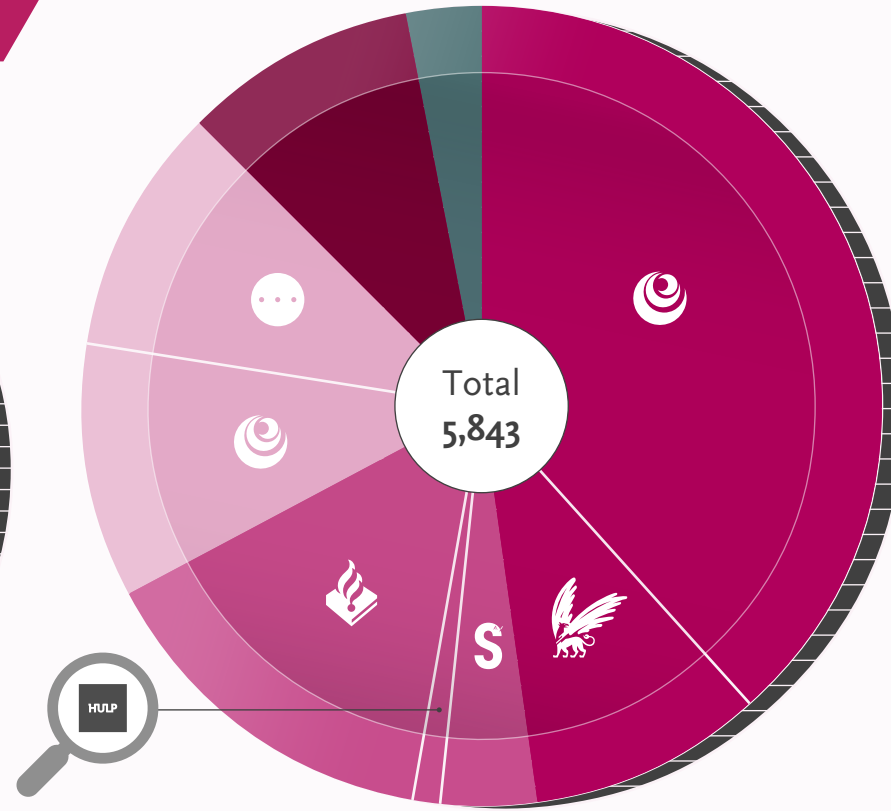
Staff (in fte) 2022 average



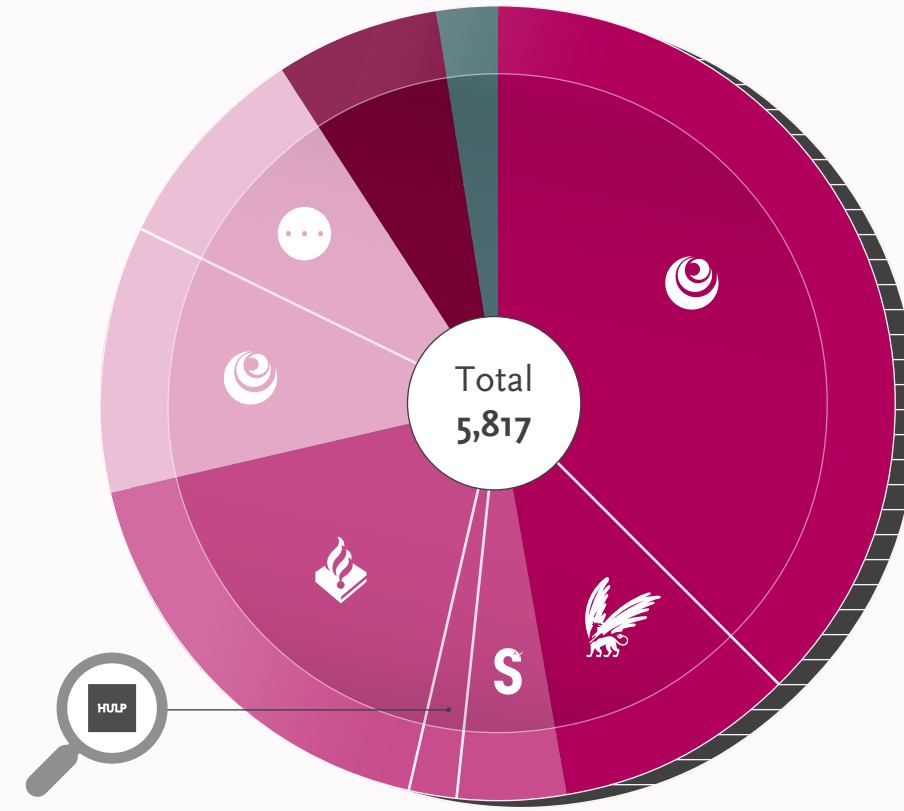
Sources of Income 2020-2022 in k€

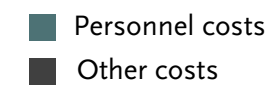
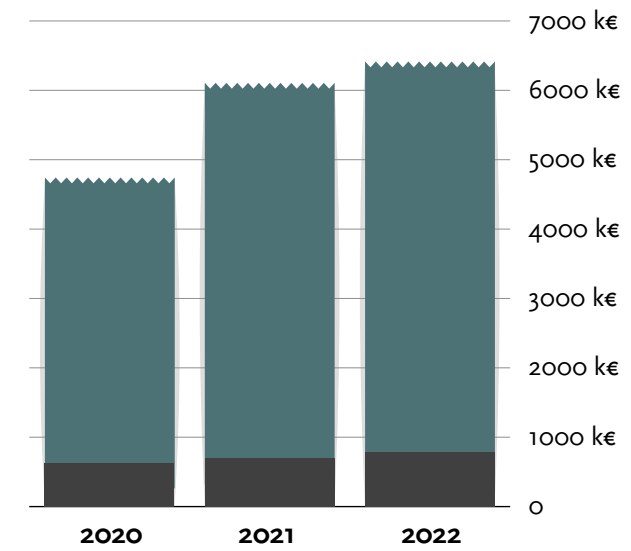
